### **Guinness World Record Attempt at Carronshore Primary School**

We are very excited to 'bee' taking part in an event to support one of our cluster primary schools. The World Record being attempted is having the most amount of people dressed as Bees in the one place. Carronshore Primary's school motto is "Bee the Best You Can Bee" and this event is in celebration of this, as well as emphasising the importance of Bees environmentally. The event will take place on the morning of **Thursday 29 March at Carronshore Primary**. All S1 will be participating. Children and adults must be dressed as Bees and there is specific criteria for this. You must wear-

- **Black and yellow stripes**
- **Wings (any colour)**
- **Antennae on your head**

If you have items at home you can send them in with your child. If not we have been making antennae and wings in Art class this month. We would just ask your child to come to school next Thursday in a black/dark top taped or painted with yellow stripes, or a yellow top, taped or painted with black stripes. If you are unable to do this we can **tape** them in school prior to the event.

On the morning on the 29<sup>th</sup>, S1 pupils should make their way to the Assembly Hall at Larbert High School for 8:40am. They will be walking to Carronshore in their form classes, supervised by staff. We will be there for around an hour then come back for lunch at school.

All participants need to be registered. We will register the children but if you are attending with us the link for registration is <https://www.ticketsource.co.uk/date/454324>. Please print and bring your ticket along with you.

Carronshore Primary have asked that if at all possible cars are not used. No vehicle will be allowed to move for half an hour before the event or afterwards. There will be signs for each school taking part and First Aiders will be on hand.
