If you and your child complete the course, you will be eligible for a **CREST Discovery award** which is recognised by Universities and Colleges.

The course is free to attend and will provide you with an insight into STEM at Larbert High School. As part of the programme, you and your child will be provided with a STEM toolkit in order to complete a STEM challenge at home. This challenge will be presented at the Celebration Event. No experience is required and the experience is focused on developing skills in an informal environment.
