Digital Technology

Larbert High is committed to using digital technology to further enhance the learning experience and achievements of all pupils. Over the last four years' digital technology has played a pivotal part in the development of our whole school Learning and Teaching policy.

In November we will be launching our 1:1 device pilot with S3 students. As part of this, all S3 pupils will be provided with an iPad to support their learning both in and out of school with the aim of enhancing feedback. This focus is based around research carried out by the Education Endowment Fund which has proven that this has the most significant impact on attainment.

Pupils have been made aware of this within school and very excited at this prospect. Over the next three weeks' pupils will meet their iPads on a number of occasions through MESP lessons. This is to ensure that on the launch evening that all parents and pupils must attend, you can take part in the 'meet your device' session and complete all required contracts.

The launch events will take place on **Monday 26** and **Tuesday 27 November** from **6pm to 7pm** in Larbert High. All pupils and parents **must** attend **one** of the evenings to be issued with their device.


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As part of the implementation process pupils and parents will be able to attend additional support sessions after the school day which we will publicise at the launch event.
